Up to \$9M is available in grants through the California Department of Food and Agriculture to fund energy-efficient refrigeration equipment in corner stores, small businesses, and food donation programs in low-income areas or communities with low access to full-service grocery stores. Recipients should prioritize stocking California-grown fresh produce, nuts, dairy, meat, eggs, culturally appropriate and minimally processed foods.

The program improves access to fresh foods in underserved communities, while supporting CA farmers and small businesses.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Corner stores, small businesses, and food donation programs may apply directly; or cities, counties and nonprofits may apply on their behalf and use up to 20% of total grant awards to provide technical assistance with selecting and stocking new units.

Grantees will choose energy-efficient and climate friendly refrigeration units that meet their needs.

Applications must be submitted online through CDFA's AmpliFund system by June 6, 2023
